Undergraduate Degree Programs

- **Grassland Systems:** An interdisciplinary, holistic approach to the study of grasslands. Students learn to integrate their developing knowledge of the resource base, as well as economic and policy considerations, into the management of grasslands for a diversity of uses.
 - **Grazing Livestock Systems Option:** focus on beef cattle production on rangelands/grasslands.
 - **Grassland Ecology and Management Option:** focus on the ecology, conservation, and multiple use of rangelands/grasslands.

RESEARCH
